## Apples to Apples

Get ten apples (or any fruit, or potatoes, they just need to be the same) and set them on a counter or table. These apples represent money you may have. Take away one or two apples and set them aside. These apples represent an amount of money to give to help others. Then set aside one or two more apples. These represent an amount of money you are saving for later. The rest of the apples represent what you have to use now.

**LOOK** at how God wants you to use your money. Give some of it away first, save some of it next, and then enjoy the rest.

## Use It Wisely

When you get money for your birthday, a holiday, or any other reason, decide how you are going to use it. Make three columns on a piece of notebook paper. At the top of one column, write “Give.” At the top of the second column, write “Save.” At the top of the third column write “Spend.” Pray and ask God to help you decide how much to write in each column. Then ask a grownup to help you divide the money into jars.

**ASK** God to help you use what He has given you well.

**Pray:** God, everything I have comes from you. Please help me to use it wisely. Amen.
