You will be speaking by the power of the Spirit, but it will all be mysterious. 3 But one who prophesies strengthens others, encourages them, and comforts them. 4 A person who speaks in tongues is strengthened personally, but one who speaks a word of prophecy strengthens the entire church.

1 John 4:1-6 NLT

Dear friends, do not believe everyone who claims to speak by the Spirit. You must test them to see if the spirit they have comes from God.

If the word is given in a corporate setting Paul says;

1 Corinthians 14:29 NLT

29 Let two or three people prophesy, and let the others evaluate what is said.

1 Thessalonians 5:19-21 NLT

19 Do not stifle the Holy Spirit. 20 Do not scoff at prophecies, 21 but test everything that is said. Hold on to what is good.

Question to ask:*

- 1. Does the word edify, exhort or comfort you?
- 2. What is the spirit behind the prophecy?
- 3. Does it conform to the Scripture?
- 4. Does it display the character of Christ?
- 5. Is it manipulative or controlling?
- 6. Does it usurp your will?
- 7. Does it pull rank?
- 8. Does it conform to what God is saying to you?

- 9. Does it allow outside perspective?
- 10. Does it give a dire warning?
- 11. How do you feel about the word in your spirit?
- 12. Is it confirmed by the church?
- 13. Does it come to pass?
- 14. Does it produce fruit?

Responding to Prophecy:*

- 1. Keep a journal
- 2. Do not interpret the word by the desires of your flesh
- 3. Embrace the word
- 4. Pray it through
- 5. Obey the word
- 6. Look for fulfillment of the word
