Why Was Jesus Born in Bethlehem?

FIRST ANSWER - ABOVE THE SURFACE - FPICENTER

Isaiah 9:6-7 NLT

6 For a child is born to us, a son is given to us. The government will rest on his shoulders. And he will be called: Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. 7 His government and its peace will never end. He will rule with fairness and justice from the throne of his ancestor David for all eternity. The passionate commitment of the Lord of Heaven's Armies will make this happen!

What does Bethlehem mean?

- Beth = House
- Lehem = Bread
- So Bethlehem means House of Bread.

Bread was a means of survival.

Egypt to Freedom

SECOND ANSWER - BELOW THE SURFACE - HYPOCENTER

- Freedom was not getting out of captivity.
- Freedom was not getting into The Promise Land.
- Freedom for the Israelites meant an intimate relationship with God.

Freedom means that there is nothing blocking you from a deep and intimate relationship with Jesus. Freedom is dependence on Jesus.

If you are dependent on Jesus you have found true freedom.
